Meningitis B - Is your child protected?

2-5 months	4 vaccines
6-23 months	3 vaccines
2 yrs+	2 vaccines

Did you know that Meningitis B is the leading cause of bacterial meningitis in children and adolescents?

Meningitis B is a bacterial infection of the meninges, the delicate lining around our brain which can cause brain damage and limb loss in around 1 in 4 people. Bexsero® is a new vaccine protecting all age groups, which means that you don't have to leave it to chance; you now have a choice! The Department of Health has recommended this vaccine but introducing it via the NHS could be a slow process – and children over 2 months will not be eligible. To protect your children, why not give them this vital vaccine NOW? Depending on your child's age they will need 2, 3 or 4 vaccines – check the chart above.

The great thing about the vaccine is that it can be administered at the same time as other useful and important vaccines such as Chickenpox or travel jabs. As Dr Lewis says, "As soon as the vaccine became available, I gave my three children the jab; much better to be safe than sorry!"

Meningitis W - Is your teenager protected?

In the last few weeks the Department of Health has reported a large rise in the number of teenagers suffering from Meningitis W.

There's a plan to roll out a nationwide vaccination programme for teenagers but no start date has yet been announced. We're ahead of the game and are delighted to be able to offer this vaccine NOW - only one shot is needed. It is suitable for all teenagers especially those embarking on a university course and children of any age can be vaccinated.

Summer Holiday – are your vaccines up to date?

We'll also keep a record of your jabs for future reference, give you a completed vaccination booklet and call you for top ups and boosters when appropriate.

We will organise your malaria medication too. Don't get caught out if you're visiting family or friends – it's still vitally important to get vaccinated.
